Councillor Tarallo moved that the City Council minutes of September 27, 2010 be as amended. The motion carried.

## **Special Permit**

American Towers, Inc. as successors by merger to Waltham Towers Inc., of 370 Prospect Hill Road, Waltham, Massachusetts, and Bell Atlantic Mobile of Massachusetts Corporation, Ltd., d/b/a Verizon Wireless, c/o Daniel D. Klasnick, Duval, Klasnick & Pastel LLC of 10 Cedar Street, Suite 17, Woburn, Massachusetts hereby petitions the City Council for a Special Permit pursuant to Sections 3.512, 3.621, 10.531(b), 10.541(b) and 10.56 of the City of Waltham Zoning Ordinance, to install, operate and maintain wireless communication equipment on the existing lattice tower located on the property at 50 Bear Hill Road (Atlas Map R57, Block 1, Lot 1A), consisting of the removal of one (1) existing 4 foot dish antenna located at a centerline height of 70 feet on the tower and replacement with one (1) new 4 foot dish antenna at 70 feet, the removal of six (6) PCS antennas located at a centerline height of 149 feet on the tower and replacement with three (3) LTE antennas and three (3) PCS antennas at 149 feet, and coaxial cabling that will run down the existing tower to an existing ground based equipment shelter. The proposal is shown on the Plans submitted by the Petitioners.

Due notice having been given, President Brasco opened the hearing and speaking in favor was Earl Duval, 10 Cedar Street Suite 17, Woburn MA, attorney for the petitioner and Stephen Russell, representative for Verizon Wireless. No one stood or spoke in favor or in opposition and that portion of the public hearing was declared closed.

Councillor Brasco opened the Public Hearing to questions from Councillors. Councillor Romard yielded the floor to Councillor Tarallo, chairman of the Ordinance and Rules Committee. On a request by Councillor Tarallo, Attorney Duval gave a brief history of the special permit. It was determined that a decision from the Building Director regarding the structure was still pending. Required action was necessary on the special permit. The attorney for the petitioner stated that a time extension was submitted to the Council. That portion of the public hearing was declared closed. Councillor Tarallo moved to take the letter for the time extension out of order. The motion carried. Councill Tarallo moved to act on the extension of time without committee reference. The motion carried. Councillor Tarallo moved approval of the extension of time The roll was called to adopt the time extension order. Voting yea were Councillors Collura, Curtin, Darcy, Giordano, LeBlanc,

Logan, Marchese, Marcou, McMenimen, Romard, Rourke, Stanley, Tarallo, and Waddick. Order # 31442 was adopted.

Waltham Towers Inc., of 370 Prospect Hill Road, Waltham, Massachusetts, and Bell Atlantic Mobile of Massachusetts Corporation, Ltd., d/b/a Verizon Wireless, c/o Daniel D. Klasnick, Duval, Klasnick & Pastel LLC of 10 Cedar Street, Suite 17, Woburn, Massachusetts hereby petitions the City Council for a Special Permit pursuant to Sections 3.512, 10.521(b) and 10.56 of the City of Waltham Zoning Ordinance, to install, operate and maintain wireless communication equipment on the rooftop of the existing building located on the property at 190 Willow Street (Atlas Map R071, Block 003, Lot 0019), including the installation of four (4) antennas on a ballast frame at a height of 46.5" above ground level; eight (8) antennas on a steel frame at a height of 49.66' above ground level; an 11'6" x 30' equipment shelter to be placed on a steel frame and painted to match existing penthouse and HVAC units, which will extend to a height of 48.5' above ground level; cable trays on sleepers; a natural gas emergency back up generator to be located inside of the proposed equipment shelter; electric and telephone lines on sleepers from the proposed equipment shelter to existing sources in the building; and two (2) GPS antennas to be mounted on the equipment shelter for E-911 compliance.
