## COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Minutes of the Meeting November 5, 2018

- 1. Vice-President Logan called the meeting to Order at 8:10pm.
- 2. Vice-President Logan requested that a roll call be taken to record the attendance for the meeting. The Clerk called the roll Councillors Brasco, Darcy, Fowler, Harris, LaCava, D. Leblanc, R. LeBlanc, Mackin, McLaughlin, McMenimen, Nabulime, Romard, Stanley, Vidal and Logan were present.
- 3. President LeBlanc moved to approve the minutes of the COW meeting held on October 15, 2018. The motion was adopted on a voice vote and the minutes of October 15, 2018 were approved.
- 4. President LeBlanc rose to speak on the matter of the executive session minutes for several meetings that were held in the COW. President LeBlanc stated that the COW Clerk had provided electronic copies via e-mail and if any Councillor needed a hard copy to contact the COW Clerk. Councillor McMenimen stated that when executive session minutes were being considered for approval, they were first reviewed by the Law Department.
