- Andy: Possibly we should provide networking time. Tony: Maybe at end for those who want to network.
- There should be presentations for WEAC programs: GC (Kathy), Energy Audits, PV (Andy).
- Kathy: We should have a subsequent discussion on how we use the WEAC 1/2 hour .. maybe after this meeting or at the January WEAC meeting.
- We will ask the Mayor if she'd like to introduce the committee (Kathy will ask).
- Andy suggested a format. We present deck of slides (computer sourced) with 1 or 2 supplied by each presenting group and someone from the group speaking to it/them. This will keep it fast, cover a lot of groups, and keep us in control.
- In wanting to get every group represented, we could go around the room by group with 1 representative each describing the group.

We will provide guidelines as to what the sentence should be about (energy for example).
