Grade Crossing Replacement
Weekend of November 1st and 2nd
Closure from approximately 1am Saturday to 8pm Sunday

On Saturday November 1st, 2014 at approximately 1am Keolis construction personnel will commence the reconstruction of the grade crossing at Elm Street in Waltham, MA. At this time the crossing will be closed to vehicular traffic through Sunday evening, November 2nd, until approximately 8pm.

Police details will be in place to mitigate any traffic issues. Access to local area residents and businesses will be maintained throughout construction by detour.

The grade crossing will be closed throughout the weekend as construction crews remove and replace the existing track structures at this location, and upgrade signal systems and utilities as needed.

Paving operations are anticipated to be completed Sunday evening by 8PM and the road reopened for use by the public. Variable message boards are on site to alert motorists and neighbors of this weekend closure.

In order to support construction efforts, ALL MBTA Fitchburg Line Commuter Rail weekend service has been suspended through November 16th 2014. For more information on the weekend service suspension please go to www.MBTA.com
