INCOME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS, YR 40: 2014 -2015

The federal government requires that social service programs funded with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds serve a majority of households with adjusted gross incomes below 80% of the Boston Area Median Household Income (MHI), which was determined to be **\$94,100** by HUD as of December 2013. If awarded a grant please contact the Planning Department for updated income limits in January 2015. Current income limits based on family size are as follows:
