Sharrow: (noun) / share-oh /Roadway Shared Lane Marking or Shared-Use Arrow

What do Sharrows Mean to Motorists & Bicyclists?

Sharrows remind motorists to expect & share the road with bicyclists

Motorists may pass bicyclists on the left with at least 3' clearance

Bicyclists should ride with motorists & avoid the dangerous parked car 'door zone'
