

Waltham City Council Public Works and Public Safety Committee Minutes Monday, March 5, 2018

Resolution Crosswalk Safety

President Leblanc, Councillor Harris, and Councillor Romard all spoke about pedestrian safety and crosswalk safety. Councillor Randy LeBlanc thanked the President for brining in the resolution. Councillor Randy LeBlanc moved to hear from an off committee member, the Wires Inspector who is a member of the Traffic Commission. The motion was approved on a voice vote. Wires Inspector Tim Kelly reviewed the history of sidewalk signs before the Traffic Commission. Councillor Romard moved approval of a request from President LeBlanc moved to invite the Traffic Engineer to the next meeting of the Public Works and Public Safety Committee to discuss the resolution.
