Councillor Harris moved approval of minutes from 4/21/2020. The motion was approved on a voice vote.

*Acceptance of a letter agreement from the Town of Belmont for 50% of the anticipated cost for replacement of the culvert in Trapelo Road, at Beaver Brook, which is 1/2 in Waltham and 1/2 in Belmont.*

Councillor Harris moved to hear from Councilor McLaughlin. The motion was approved on a voice vote. Councilor McLaughlin reviewed the history of the site and spoke in favor of the request from the Mayor to accept the letter agreement. Councillor LaFauci asked questions about the design and timeline. Councillor Harris moved approval. The motion was approved on a voice vote and the matter was forwarded to the full Council with a recommendation for approval.

*17-80 Silver Hill Lane*

*Private Way Resolution*

Councilor Darcy spoke about the process for converting streets from Private to Public and that this gives the authority over subdivisions off of the street to the Board of Survey and Planning. Councillor LaFauci moved to lay the matter on the table. The motion was approved on a voice vote.
