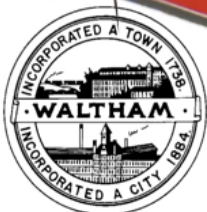

Please take the following steps:

1. **ELIMINATE** food and water sources:
 - Use tight-fitting lids on all trash containers and do not put trash out until 4pm the day before pickup.
 - Keep food off the ground - pick up fruit and vegetables, and enclose compost.
 - Avoid creating water sources through drips or leaks from AC units and hoses.
2. **MAINTAIN** your property to eliminate rodent shelter. Keep vegetation trimmed, remove trash and debris, close all building openings larger than a quarter inch.
3. **CHECK** for rodent activity (burrows, droppings, gnaw marks, food stores) and **EXTERMINATE** as necessary.
