

Stray Pets and Wild Animals Can Give You Rabies

Follow these rules to protect yourself and your pets from RABIES:

- ✓ Don't go near wild animals, even ones that appear tame.
- ✓ Stay away from stray dogs and cats.
- ✓ Have your pets been vaccinated? Ask your parents.
- Keep outdoor trash cans tightly covered and don't leave pet food outside.
- Tell an adult if you are scratched or bitten.
