

# CPC Narrative Concerning Restoration of the Historic MetFern Cemetery

### **Project Narrative**

This project is to use Waltham CPA funds to restore the historic MetFern Cemetery located along Trapelo Road behind Mackerel Hill in North Waltham.

The MetFern Cemetery contains the remains of approximately 300 individuals who resided at the former Fernald State School and the former Metropolitan State Hospital. The MetFern cemetery had burials between 1947 and 1979. See the attached National Register Historic Form.

The CPA funds will be used to locate, reset and repair the 300 cemetery monuments, repoint the adjacent stone walls, conduct an inventory of the individuals interred, remove debris (e.g. light pole bases), and erect historically accurate signage at the MetFern Cemetery. Work will be conducted under the direction of the state archaeologist in concert with the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation.

Currently, and regrettably, the vast majority of those interred are identified on monuments only with a letter ("C" or "P") followed by a number. "C" indicated Catholic, "P" indicated Protestant. This project will erect historically accurate signs with interred full names. This project will bring dignity and respect to those former MetState and Fernald residents interred at this cemetery.
