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Project Narrative

This project is to use CPA funds to restore historic farming opera ons at the former William Wellington house and farm on Trapelo Road.

The yellow mushroom shaped parcel under considera on for farming is 5.65 acres in size and located at 775 BEF Trapelo Road, immediately



adjacent to and to the east of the historic William Wellington House located at 775 Trapelo Road. The 775 BEF Trapelo parcel is owned by the City and is currently under care and control of the Waltham Recrea on Department. This area was ac vely farmed for hundreds of years un I approximately 1990.

This applica on used a clearing cost of \$5,000 per acre, including tree clearing and stump removal. These es mates were obtained via discussions with a tree company back in 2016. The applica on also includes a small amount of funding for plan ng missing specimen trees, reestablishing the historic fruit orchards, as well as repairing and repoin ng the historic stone walls. There is a connegency rate of 10%.

Once the land has been cleared, the City of Waltham would then issue an RFP to lease the land for farming opera ons. RFP requirements may include (a) dona ng a small percentage of the produce to not-for-pro t food pantries (b) allowing public school children limited access to the farm for educational eld trips and (c) plan ng a wild ower and pumpkin eld.
