Applications and all supporting documentation must be submitted as hardcopy with eleven (11) copies (including one unbound for reproduction) to the official mailing address as specified in Article VI. If an Application is recommended for funding by the CPC, then an additional 17 copies must be provided for use by the City Council.

Applicants are encouraged to include any maps, diagrams, and/or photographs pertaining to the project. Letters of support for the project from community organizations or other sources may also be submitted.

Applicants will also submit an electronic version of each and every document submitted in their application if available, either on CD or USB flash drive, preferably in Portable Document Format (PDF) or other commonly used file formats (eg. .doc, .docx, .xls, .xlsx, .jpeg).

ATTACHMENT

As with many organizations during the COVID-19 pandemic, The French Club has been closed, thereby losing most sources of income - function hall rental, alcohol sales, events, teams, raffles, etc.

The French American Victory Club (FAVC or French Club) is a social men and women's club in Waltham, Massachusetts, that preserves French Canadian and Acadian culture and heritage, as well as providing social events. All adults are welcome to apply for membership. Annual dues in 2021 are \$50. Members Meetings are held monthly with the elected officers and Board of Directors. In addition, the Board meets separately as needed. We have 250 members.

The French Club was given historic status by the City of Waltham in 2016, in recognition of the contributions of the French Canadian immigrants and their descendants to the City of Waltham. The first meeting of The French Club was held in 1944. At the time it was a men's club with a women's auxiliary formed in the 1960s. For the first few decades the French Club was an important place for French Canadian immigrant tradesmen, factory and mill workers and laborers to meet and network for jobs. Many of these immigrants and the next generations became business owners, as well as educated craftsmen and professionals in the community.

For the last few decades, with a decline of immigration from Canada and changing traditions, the Club opened its membership and welcomed women and people of all ethnic backgrounds. Since the closing of Saint Joseph's Church and Saint Pierre School, several years ago, the French Club is the only organization in Waltham that continues French Canadian traditions.

During recent years, The French Club hosted Sunday Country Jamborees twice a month, hosted by The Country Masters who have been the house band for about 50 years. Monthly oldies dances often have local band, Back in Time, as well as oldies rock and country dances (and some French songs) with DancesByLaurie. She also hosted a Halloween and New Years Eve Dance. Saint Pierre School held their alumni reunion at the French Club in September 2019. The French Club proudly participated

with a large float in the Waltham 135th Anniversary Parade in September 2019, celebrating the French Club's 75th Anniversary.

Popular activities include the horseshoe and corn hole leagues, game nights, French Canadian card games, French Canadian dinners, including ham and homemade beans and corned beef and cabbage. Two excellent pool tables are often in use. The Club maintains a small lending library of French Canadian books - cookbooks, travel, music, historic photo albums. In December we had the annual Breakfast With Santa, which was well attended, breakfast included traditional potato pancakes. Children received gifts and had photos taken with Santa.

The French Club donates the function hall and parking lot to various local organizations, including GWARC, Creative Head Start, Waltham Youth Baseball & Hockey, Special Olympics. Each year members' children or grandchildren may apply for a \$500 college scholarship.

During 2019 and up to March 2020, the French Club replaced all lighting in the Function Hall and Members Bar areas through a program with National Grid at a cost of \$6,500 (a savings of about \$13,500), which was paid off with an additional \$400 to the monthly bill.

The French Club has an excellent group of member volunteers. Decorating the hall, maintenance, painting, cooking, baking, serving, cleanup. In May 2020, in time of COVID, a group of volunteers painted the members lounge and function hall, and the exterior of the building! Currently, we are replacing all very old carpet in the function hall and members lounge with carpet tiles (estimate \$10,000).

The French Club has an active Facebook group, sharing photos of events, notices, and other culturally interesting posts. Events are also posted on Waltham Patch. The website is www.favclub.org. In addition, information about function hall rental is posted on social media and on Waltham Patch classified ads.

During 2019 we sent a letter to members requesting donations for our parking lot repair and paving project, attached. A typical activities list is also attached. A sample of our ad in Waltham Patch is attached. A sample fundraiser raffle form is attached.

When The French Club was forced to close during the COVID-19 pandemic, we started a GO FUND ME fundraiser on Facebook. We exceeded our goal of \$20,000 and raised \$23,015 through generous donations of our members and some larger donations.

In addition, Main Street Gulf held a one week \$1 per fill up for The French Club for a total generous donation of \$7,100.

Several other larger donations included \$2,000 4-LeBlancs, \$1,000 Colvin Gas, \$1,000 Bob LeBlanc, \$1,500 Waltham Towing.

DURING COVID-19

In accordance with Federal, State and Waltham guidelines, the French Club has remained closed. During the month of May 2020 French Club volunteers painted the inside and outside of the first floor (members lounge and function hall). Additional renovations were done to the inside over the past several months.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

GOAL: Upgrade the old HVAC system to the French American Victory Club.

- (1) Remove the old furnace/boiler and replace with a unit which is both energy and cost efficient. The furnace is approximately 70 years old.
- (2) Supply and install an on-demand water heater.

COMMUNITY NEED: The French Club provides a large hall, stage, kitchen and staffed bar centrally located in Waltham, which is reasonably priced and available to all the Waltham community, for weddings, showers, fundraisers, concerts, dances, etc. The French Club has a large dance floor. The hall is often rented by many of our ethnic community, including Hispanic and Ugandan, as well as others. The Club occasionally donates the hall for fundraisers.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT:

The following are proposals and quotes received for the project:

(1) **LeBlanc Mechanical LLC** - Supply and install HVAC system.

TIMELINE: For implementation and completion, estimate six months to complete.

CONTINGENCY: We expect to allow for a 20% contingency for unexpected costs.

CREDENTIALS: The Board of Directors along with experienced French Club members who are tradesmen and who can review quotes and understand the process, will work together to track the progress and measure the success of the projects.

Since the start of the French Club in 1944, members have continuously donated their time and skills for overall management and maintenance projects, which has been essential to keep The French Club running.

BUDGET: The total budget for this project is approximately **\$84,650** including the 20% contingency, with all funding being spent on the named project.

OTHER FUNDING

MAINTENANCE: All future maintenance will be included as part of The French Club annual maintenance budget.

Dear French Club Members and Friends:

The French Club had a very good season of Sunday country jamborees, occasional oldies dances, and our popular ham and bean and spaghetti suppers. Also the corn hole and horseshoe leagues are still going strong. There are game nights - Cribbage, Scat card games. And the pool tables are in demand. The annual Santa breakfast gets a good crowd. Our corned beef and cabbage dinner was a sell out this year.

We currently have 240 paid members. We continue to rent the hall and parking spaces.

Because of our historic status, we received a City of Waltham grant two years ago to install a fire sprinkler system, a handicap ramp and a ventilation hood in the kitchen.

We also replaced all the lighting in the main hall and members bar this spring through an Eversource energy savings program.

This fall the French Club is planning to apply for a new City of Waltham grant to replace the oldest furnace, install all new vinyl flooring, and paint the exterior of the building.

For all of this we are extremely grateful. Your membership and the many volunteer hours and participation in events keeps us going.

The French Club will celebrate our 75th Anniversary in October. On September 22 we will participate in Waltham's first parade in many years.

One area of immediate concern and need is the parking lot. We are not able to get City funding for this job, which we estimate to be approximately \$40,0000. It is beyond patching. We are reaching out now to all our members and friends for donations for this project. If you can give \$25, \$50 or \$100 or more to completely repair, pave and re-line the parking lot, this will get us on our way to completing this project by the Fall.






