UPCOMING PROJECTS

Bob Marcou informed the Commission a group, called Waltham Together has been formed to assist in the purchase of mask for students in Waltham School for their return to school and inquired as to the feasibility of the DSC contributing to the Group for masks in Waltham's Special Education Department. The Chairperson, Mark Johnson explained the DSC could not make a contribution to that Group as it is not a sanctioned City entity, but could take a vote on funding allocation to the City's Special Ed. Department to aid in the purchase of masks for the students in Waltham that have different types of abilities if the remaining funds in the Special Education Department are adequate.

Upon a motion Robert Marcou and second by Jane Demers it was,

VOTED:

That an amount not to exceed \$1,000 be awarded to the City's Special Education Department if the balance in that account allows. The Commission also agreed we would review the matter in the future if the Special Education Department should require more financial assistance with the needs of disabled students due to the pandemic.
