# STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES STREET SWEEPING

## 1. Preparation

- a. Prioritize cleaning routes to use at the highest frequency in areas with the highest pollutant loading.
- b. Restrict street parking prior to and during sweeping using regulations as necessary
- c. Sweeping occurs continuously throughout the year. Weather permitting sweeping occurs in winter without water.
- d. Perform preventative maintenance and services on sweepers to increase and maintain their efficiency

### 2. Process

- a. Streets are to be swept as needed or specified by the city. Street maps are used to ensure all streets are swept at a specified interval (see attached)
- b. Sweeping occurs on Main and Moody Streets every Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- c. The streets are swept five (5) a year city-wide.
- d. Drive street sweeper safely and pickup debris
- e. When full, the sweeper dumps into a dump truck that brings the debris back to the City Yard.

#### 3. Clean-up

- a. Street sweepers are to be cleaned in the washbay at City Yard.
- b. Street sweeping cleaning stations shall separate the solids from the liquids.
- c. Once solids have dried out, City contractor transports it for disposal at an approved facility.
- d. Decant water is to be collected and routed to an approved wastewater collection system area only.
- e. City contractor hauls the dumped material to an appropriate disposal facility.

#### 4. Documentation

- a. Keep accurate logs to track streets swept and streets still requiring sweeping.
- b. Log the amount of debris collected and hauled off.
