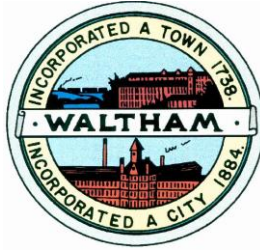

Fernald Use Committee July 17, 2017 Minutes of the meeting

Chairman McLaughlin called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Attendance: Councillor Darcy, Councillor O'Brien, Councillor Waddick, Chairman McLaughlin.

Councillor Waddick made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 26, 2017 meeting. Motion was adopted on a voice vote.

Chairman McLaughlin reminded the committee that the meeting was called for the purpose of commenting on the School Committee's request for information on what uses the City Council would like to see on the Fernald site.

Councillor Waddick suggested that the School Committee's question is premature without more specific additional information from them regarding how much space they need, and what their layout would be. Councillor Waddick said the City Council should not take anything off the table until they know more.

Councillor Darcy said the City should consider the importance of the restoration of wetlands protect, and for drainage retention near the pond area where it had been previously.

Councillor Darcy said he hopes the western greenway remains in the area that has been previously discussed and identified.

Council President LeBlanc said the committee should consider moving the resolutions for the Western Greenway and water retention out to the City Council.
