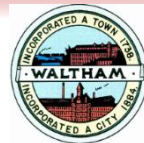

The Waltham Fire Department
would like the opportunity to help you make your home safer.

- The Waltham Fire Department is offering a program, **free of charge**, to assist with checking your residence for the appropriate smoke and carbon monoxide protection.



- With your written consent, the Waltham Fire Department will schedule a date and time to have a Fire Department representative (a *uniformed officer from the Fire Prevention office*) drop by your home for a brief consultation visit.

- This brief consultation visit is to ensure that you have the proper type smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and they are situated throughout your home in the proper locations and that these devices are tested as functioning.



- In cases of missing detection the department may make recommendations to replace or add detection.

- In some cases, we will install the detection for you!
Again, **free of charge!**
