


Discussion

Fiske Street was developed by the Fiske heirs from the estate that had been situated on Main Street, and the plan was laid out in 1888. Jasper Leon Fiske sold the property with a house on it to sisters Mary and Elizabeth Manning in 1898. The house was therefore built between 1888 and 1898. The property came before the Commission in 2015 for a demolition of the carriage house, which had been condemned for unsanitary conditions. The house has some nice details on it, and fits well with the other Victorian houses on the street. The proposed house uses the generic design that is being erected all over the city, although the garages are not included. No one of historical significance lived in the house.

Conclusion

The house was built before 1898, and is therefore over 75 years old. No one of historical significance lived in the house.
