




Summary

The house at 26 Friend Street was likely built by Patrick McLaughlin in 1868. McLaughlin and his family lived there until 1888, and the property was rented to various tenants until his heirs sold it in 1914. McLaughlin worked for he bleachery. Patrick & Lucy Powers lived in the house from 1923 to 1944. Powers was a lineman for the telephone company. Patrick and Grace O'Connell owned the house from 1949 to 2017, when it was sold to Patrick O'Connell Jr. O'Connell was the foreman of the Waltham DPW. No one of historical significance lived in the house, which is a simple worker's residence.
