

Intent of Project

The city seeks a company to offer on-site or off-site medical services to its most vulnerable populations (youth, homeless, disabled, veterans, low income, etc.) to include but not limited to primary care. These populations are often underserved in the medical community and Waltham seeks to overcome that challenge by providing affordable and accessible health care to these individuals. The city wishes to engage a company(s) or organization(s) with experience treating vulnerable populations and screening these individuals. The services shall be provided for 52 weeks and billed to the City with monthly invoices by dividing the lump sum yearly bid amount in 12 equal increments.

Specifications

If Federally Funded

If this project is a Federally Funded activity and if the City has applied for and received funds from the United States Government under the provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, Public Law 93-383; and Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance Number 14.218; the services provided under this activity must comply with HUD contract provisions 24CFR part 85.36(I), Nondiscrimination, Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action, Section 3 requirements, Anti-Kickback Act, Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act and Department of Labor Standards and all other Federal, State and Local regulations as set forth in the contract documents. - Blood screenings and flu shots for employees and dependents unable to attend City sponsored events

EXHIBIT A. ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT

CITY OF WALTHAM

The Agreement by and between the CITY and CONTRACTOR is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE 5. CONTRACTOR will provide services under this Agreement beginning on January 2, 2018.

ARTICLE 6. CONTRACTOR will provide services as listed in the Specifications with the following modifications:

- a. Intake screening shall be conducted by a Community Health Worker, with additional support provided by a Registered Nurse (RN) or Nurse Practitioner (NP) as needed.
- b. Those individuals screened by the CONTRACTOR whose screening indicates a need for social services will be referred to the appropriate organization/agency.
- c. Those individuals screened by the CONTRACTOR whose screening indicates a need for clinical services will be referred to the appropriate provider based on the individual's preference:
 - i. If the individual wishes to become a patient of CONTRACTOR, clinical services will be provided after the individual has followed CONTRACTOR's standard process for becoming a new patient.
 - ii. If the individual screened is a patient at a practice other than CONTRACTOR or wishes to become a patient at a practice other than CONTRACTOR, the CONTRACTOR will help connect the individual with the practice/provider the individual wishes to see.
- d. CONTRACTOR will not provide clinical services to individuals who are not its patients, given lack of medical history and other key health information such as allergies and medications. The only exception to this are public health clinics CONTRACTOR wishes to perform outside of this Agreement, such as public flu vaccine clinics available to anyone in the community.
