Enclosed please find a communication from the Chief of Police. Chief MacPherson is available to answer any questions you may have regarding this request.

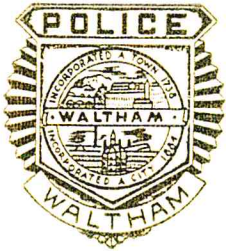
