THE BLACK SWALLOW-WORT

If you find Black Swallow-Wort on your own property:

Dig up the plant with entire root system, put it in a sealed plastic bag and dispose of it in the trash. Do NOT put into yard waste bags or in your compost! The roots will resprout and seeds are not destroyed in composting operations.







FLOWERS: Small, purple, starshaped



LEAVES: Shiny, green, come in pairs, quickly winding around fences/shrubs



ROOTS: White & fleshy tentacles that break off easily

SEED PODS:

Pull when pods are still slim, smooth And green before they open *Be careful pulling brown, papery pods that have already opened up - Mature seeds easily escape!



INVASIVE PLANT - PUT PODS OR PLANTS (WITH ROOTS) IN SEALED PLASTIC BAG AND PUT IN THE TRASH



DO NOT PUT PODS OR PLANTS IN YARD WASTE OR COMPOST
