Case #: 2016-29. Petitioner/Owner: Carmarvia Real Estate Holdings, LLC. c/o Carl E. D'Angio. Nature of Application/Petition: Application for Variance – Confirm existing setbacks, lot coverage and parking and Application for Special Permit - Conversion of existing non-conforming commercial use to residential use. Subject Matter: The Petitioner requests the Board to allow the conversion of existing space on the first floor of the building at 53-55 Brown Street into a residential apartment. This will result in a totally residential building containing a total of three (3) units. Location and Zoning District: 53-55 Brown Street; Residence B Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance **Involved:** Section 3.7223 – special permit, Section 4.11 – confirm existing conditions and Article 5 – confirm existing parking. Specific Relief Sought: Article 3, Section 3.7223 requires a special permit for a change to a similar but not less restricted use. Article 4, Section 4.11 requires certain lot size, setbacks, lot coverage and Article 5 requires certain parking - The existing non-conforming building after remodeling of the commercial space on the first floor into one (1) residential unit will result in a fully residential building having a total of three (3) dwelling units. The size, location and parking of the building will not be changed. This change in use of the first floor will be a less intense use of the building and parking.
