Case #: 2012-01. Petitioner(s)/Owner(s): Ariel Segall. Nature of Appeal/Petition: Application for a Variance and Application for Special Permit. Subject Matter: To allow the use of the basement floor of an existing building known as 96 Lyman Street #1 for a gourmet chocolate/confections business. This will result in the construction of a commercial kitchen and the use of the property for production (but not retail sales) of gourmet chocolates and other confections. The lot, building and parking will not be affected. The size, location and parking of the building will not be changed. Location and Zoning District: 96 Lyman St #1: Residential B Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article 3, Section 3.210 permits the Inspector of Buildings to approve the use of up to ¹/₄ of a residence for a Customary Home Specific Manner in Which Subject Matter Varies From Zoning Occupation. **Ordinance:** Confectionery is not explicitly listed as a "Customary Home Occupation" in section 3.210, but is one, and is no more intensive than dressmaking, millinery, or other listed occupations. The size, location and parking of the building will not be changed.
