Nature of Appeal/Petition: Application for Special Permit to convert former nursing home to four (4) unit residential building. **Subject Matter**: The Petitioner seeks to convert and reconstruct a former 19 bed nursing home into a multi-family building consisting of four (4) units. The building is known and numbered as 64 Curve Street (formerly known as 508 Lexington Street). All other provisions of the Zoning Ordinance shall be met and the required parking shall be provided. Location and Zoning District: 64 Curve Street, (formerly known as 508 Lexington Street), Residence A-3 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance **Involved**: Article III, §3.73 (as further defined and controlled by subsections 3.371 through 3.734). Specific Manner in Which Subject Matter Varies From Zoning **Ordinance**: Article III, §3.73 (as further defined and controlled by subsections 3.371 through 3.734) requires an issuance of a Special Permit prior to conversion/reconstruction of a nursing home/rest home building into a multi-family dwelling. The Petitioner proposes to convert a former 19 bed nursing home into a four (4) unit multi-family building.
