Subject Matter: The locus consists of a large parcel containing 65.697 acres of land. The Petitioner proposes to construct, use and maintain three snow canopies at the existing structure for the purpose of sheltering entrances and exits. Location and Zoning District: 35 Gatehouse Drive, Limited Commercial Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article IV, §4.11. Specific Manner in Which Subject Matter Varies From Zoning Ordinance: In Case No. 97-15, this Board of Appeals granted a height variance for the locus to construct, use and maintain a structure on the locus. In Case No. 06-22, this Board of Appeals granted a variance for the locus to construct, use and maintain an addition to the existing structure on the locus.
