THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS OF THE CITY OF WALTHAM WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN THE GOVERNMENT CENTER, 119 SCHOOL STREET, WALTHAM, MA ON NOVEMBER 13, 2012 AT 7:00 P.M. ON THE FOLLOWING:

Case No.: 2012-25. **Petitioner:** Adam Stack. **Owner:** Advanced Mechanical Solutions, Inc. **Nature of Application/Petition:** Application to Modify and amend terms/conditions in Case #2012-19 converting a four family to a three family. **Subject Matter:** the Petitioner requests the Board to allow the modification and amendment of a grant of modification in Case #2012-19 which allowed conversion of a four family to a three family by amending the decision to allow the Petitioner to continue to retain and maintain the existing two car garage on the property known and numbered as 179-181 Brown Street. All other provisions of the granted petition, in case #2012-19, are to remain the same. **Location and Zoning District:** 179-181 Brown Street, Residence B Zoning District. **Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved:** Allow modification and amendment of petition granted by Board of Appeals on August 7, 2012 in case #2012-19. The Board has power to do this under Article VII, Section 7.2. **Specific Manner in Which Subject Matter Varies from Zoning Ordinance:** The Petitioner is asking that the Board of Appeals allowed a modification of a special permit granted in Case #2012-19, by allowing the Petitioner to continue to retain and maintain the existing two-car garage on the property – previously, in Case 2012-19, the Petitioner had asked to take down the garage.
