Case #: 2013-28. **Petitioner:** 232 Realty LLC. **Nature of Appeal:** Application for a special permit to change to similar use and Appeal from decision of Building Inspector. **Subject Matter:** Petitioner requests a special permit to utilize residentially zoned land which has been used by the City of Waltham as a gravel bank and storage area to be utilized as an area for storage of construction supplies and building materials associated with the Ideal Concrete Block business operated on the adjacent property at 232 Lexington Street as a similar use of not less restricted character. Petitioner appeals the decision of the Building Inspector prohibiting use of the nonconforming residentially zoned land adjacent to 232 Lexington Street for the purpose of storage of construction supplies and building materials associated with the Ideal Concrete Block business without a special permit. Location and Zoning District: 17 AFT Varnum Park, Residence A-3 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article III, Section 3.7223 (Nonconforming Buildings, Structures and uses) which allows a nonconforming property to be changed to a similar use of not less restricted character when a special permit therefore has been granted by the Board of Appeals authorizing such a change. Article VII, Section 7.3 (Procedure on Appeals) which allows a person aggrieved by a ruling by the Building Inspector to appeal the ruling to the Board of Specific Manner in Which Subject Matter Varies From Zoning Appeals. **Ordinance:** The parcel is zoned Residence A-3 which does not permit commercial uses as a matter of right.
