Case #: 2018-01. Petitioner/Owner: Aggregate Industries – Northeast Region, Inc. Nature Of Appeal/Petition: Application for Special Permit. Subject Matter: To allow for upgrades to the non-conforming use of the property at 537 South Street which will maintain the current use as a Ready Mix Plant while providing a more modern concrete batch plant and expanded parking areas. Upgrades include two new silos, a new feed structure, new material conveyors, and a new Admix building/ storage area. Location and Zoning District: 537 South Street; Commercial Zoning District. Provisions Of Zoning **Ordinance Involved:** Article III, Section 3.7222- requires a special permit when increasing the land area use of a non-conforming use by not more than 10%. Article V, Section 5.21 – requires 1 parking space per 2 workers, based on peak employment for industrial use. Specific Relief Sought: A special permit to allow for an increase in land area use in accordance with Article III, Section 3.7222 and any other relief that the Zoning Board deems appropriate.
