Case #: 2018-08. Petitioner/Owner: Kate M. Thurman Nature Of Appeal/Petition: Application for Special Permit – Alter/Enlarge a non-conforming residential building. Subject Matter: Petitioner seeks a special permit to alter and enlarge a non-conforming single family dwelling by adding a second floor over the existing footprint. Location and Zoning District: 10 Bowdoin Avenue; Residence A-4 Zoning District. Provisions Of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article III, Section 3.7222. Specific Relief Sought: §3.7222 requires the issuance of a Special Permit prior to altering a non-conforming building where the alteration is less than 10% of the existing ground floor area. The proposed expansion is over the existing footprint and there will be no additional ground area covered.
