Specific Relief Sought: The proposed addition to the single family home is enclosing an existing exterior to create an enclosed mudroom that is 10 feet, 8 inches from the east side property line. Another proposed addition at the rear of the home encroaches on the existing garage. Originally 8 feet, 3 inches separated the house and garage, the proposed separation will be 6 feet, 8 inches.
