Case #: 2018-30. Petitioner/ Owner: Rosemary Maynes. Nature of Appeal/Petition: Application for a Variance and to Amend a Prior Variance. Subject Matter: Petitioner seeks to amend a prior variance to allow the construction of a four season room at the rear of existing dwelling which will also require a new variance. Location and Zoning District: 201 Mokema Avenue, Residence A-4 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article IV, §4.11 and Article VII, §7.32. Specific Relief Sought: Section 4.11 requires a rear yard setback of 30 feet and 20.5 feet are proposed. Section 7.32 authorizes the Board of Appeals to hear petitions for variances and therefore to amend such decisions.
