Case #: 2020-12. Petitioner/ Owner: Christopher J. Corcoran and Michele Heffernan Nature of Application/ Petition: Application for Variances – Dimensional. Subject Matter: Petitioners seek to construct an addition over a part of the second floor of their residential dwelling and to add an overhang over their front door and otherwise to continue to use and maintain the house in its current location. Location and Zoning District: 48 Knollwood Drive; Residence A-3 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article IV, Section 4.11. Specific Relief Sought: Article IV, Section 4.11 requires a front-yard setback of 25 feet and the setback from the overhang over the front door will be 21.7 feet; and Article IV, Section 4.11 limits the number of stories to 2.5 and because of the layout and design of the existing house, the proposed addition will be, by definition, 3 stories.
