Subject Matter: To allow for the construction of a single-story addition in the rear-yard setback of the Locus where the pre-existing structure sits. Location and Zoning District: 91 Robbins Street; Residence B Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: § 4.11 – Rear-yard setback. Specific Relief Sought: Petitioner proposes an addition that will sit 22.5 feet from the rear-yard lot line. The addition will have no effect on the existing 4.7 foot setback.
