Case #: 2020-32. Petitioner: John J. Aiello Owner: Estate of John P. Aiello, John J. Aiello, Administrator. Nature of Application/ Petition: Application for Variance and Special Permit. Subject Matter: Petitioner proposes to remove the encroachment on Lot 2 and render the structure and garage on Lot 1 compliant with current zoning requirements. Location and Zoning District: 122 Dale Street; Residence A-4 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: Article IV, Section 4.11 – Side and Front Yard setbacks and lot coverage for residential structures and Article III, Section 3.7225 – Rights of non-conforming buildings, structures and uses – altered, reconstructed, extended or substantially changed). Specific Relief Sought: Petitioner proposes the removal of an illegal addition to the single-family home resulting in a side yard setback of 2.37', a front-yard setback of 8.72' and lot coverage of 31.1%. In addition, Petitioner seeks to confirm the dimensional setbacks of the pre-existing garage.
