Subject Matter: To allow for the construction of a second floor over the existing single-story home and a two-story addition to the side of the home that will expand the garage from a single vehicle to two-vehicle garage. Location and Zoning District: 159 Doty Street; Residence A-3 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: §4.11. Specific Relief Sought: Petitioners seek variances for a reduced front yard setback from 26 ft to 23.3 ft and a reduced side yard setback from 15.32 ft to 7.3 ft. The other side-yard setback will remain at 13.91 ft.
