Case #: 2023-13. Petitioner/Owner: Jack & Eileen Wozek. Nature of Appeal/Petition: Special Permit. Subject Matter: The Petitioners seek an increase in the non-conforming nature of the structure in an amount not to exceed 10% of the ground floor area of the house. Petitioners propose an addition in the form of a "bump out" for their kitchen. Location and Zoning District: 35 Willow Street; Residence A-4 Zoning District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance Involved: § 3.7222. Specific Relief Sought: Locus is a legal lot with a pre-existing non-conforming structure. Pursuant to §3.7222, petitioners seek a special permit for an enlargement in that use not exceeding ten (10%) percent limit therein. Petitioner proposes a 2% increase.
