THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS OF THE CITY OF WALTHAM WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN THE GOVERNMENT CENTER, 119 SCHOOL STREET, WALTHAM, MA ON April 30, 2024 AT 7:00 P.M. ON THE FOLLOWING:

Case #: 2024-07. Petitioner/ Owner: MICOL, LLC. Nature of Appeal/Petition: Application for Variances – height, FAR, setback from a public pedestrian way and parking. Application for Modification of Variances Case #2023-06 to modify the plans. Subject Matter: Petitioner proposes to raze the existing structure and construct, use, and maintain a hotel with a restaurant, a banquet hall and an owner's residence. Petitioner was granted dimensional variances in Case #2023-06. Due to minor changes to the design, further variances are now required. Location and Zoning District: 210 Moody Street, Business C District. Provisions of Zoning Ordinance **Involved:** §§4.11, 4.12(13), 5.21, 5.231 and 5.232. Specific Relief Sought: §4.11 states maximum height is 65 feet, Case #2023-06 granted a variance for a max height of 67 feet, a height of 75.04 feet is proposed. §4.11 states that maximum number of stories is 5 and 5 stories plus a mezzanine are proposed. §4.11 states that maximum FAR is 2.5; Case #2023-06 granted a variance for an FAR of 3.45, an increased FAR of 4.82 is proposed. §4.12(13) requires a 10-foot side setback from a public pedestrian way; Case #2023-06 granted a variance for 0-foot side setback from a public way, an additional 0-foot setback is proposed. §5.21 requires 1 parking space per hotel room; §5.231 requires 1 space per 500 square feet in excess of 20.000 for non-residential uses and §5.232 requires 1.25 spaces per residential unit. A total of 56 spaces are required and 29 spaces are proposed.
