MOODY STREET BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS: NOTICE OF TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING

The City of Waltham is exploring whether to shut Moody Street down to traffic again, making the street a pedestrian zone to allow restaurants to set up tables in the street. The Waltham Traffic Commission is inviting all Moody Street businesses and area residents to attend a meeting on Thursday March 30th, where you will have the opportunity to voice your opinions.

The two options that will be explored include:

- Making Moody Street one-way southbound (from Pine St to High St) from Sundays at 7pm until Thursdays at 4pm (between Memorial Day and Labor Day), and closing all of Moody Street to vehicles (from Pine St to High St) from Thursdays at 4pm until Sundays at 7pm (between Memorial Day and Labor Day)
- A repeat of the set-up from 2020, 2021, and 2022 (pedestrian zone between Pine Street and High Street, with the block between Walnut St and Chestnut St open to traffic)

This will be an in-person meeting.
