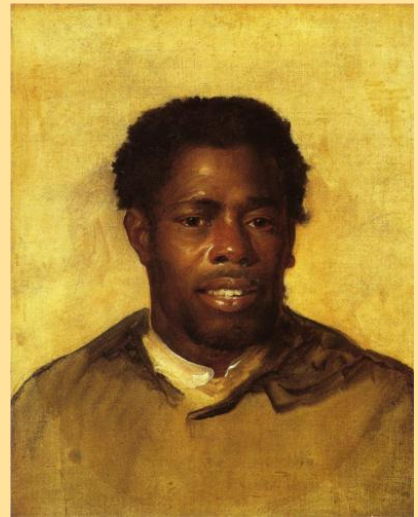


Who Tells Your Story?
