Mayor,

Thanks for meeting with us the other day to discuss the issue with the Tourism funds that were cut by the State. As you know, Steampunk and Riverfest, the two largest and most successful Downtown festivals, rely on those Tourism funds.

At the meeting, you graciously offered to try and find us replacement dollars; \$12,000 for Steampunk and \$8,000 for Riverfest.

Toward that end, I've attached Preliminary Budgets for both festivals. We've tried to organize the expenses to be paid by the City in such as to make it logistically simplest from the City's perspective. For instance, in both budgets the "Entertainers" (Steampunk) and "Music and Artists" (Riverfest) are paid by DWP because those folks all want to be paid on Festival day. And, we also assumed the City wouldn't want to pay for Special Event Insurance.

We can make whatever changes you want to be made.
