Dear Councillors:

Enclosed please find a bond appropriation for the purchase of the fee interest in the Stigmatine land.

This amount \$7.4 million plus the \$18 million prior bond comes to \$25.4 million, the price that the Stigmatine attorney provided directly to the City Council. This figure was never provided to the Law Department nor to the Mayor during the pendency of the legal agreement/extensions between the Stigmatine Fathers, Inc. and the City of Waltham.

As a matter of fact, no price (purchase or appraisal or requested) was ever provided by the Stigmatines' attorney to the Law Department nor to the Mayor despite the legal agreement/extensions between the Stigmatine Fathers, Inc. and the City of Waltham, and despite several requests for a price and appraisal.

The Law Department and I are available to answer any questions you may have regarding this request.
