1. Councillor Romard moved to take the matter of grant of location for Exchange Street off the table. Motion was adopted on a voice vote.

Police Chief MacPherson, CPW Director Chiasson and Maureen Carroll from Eversource were in attendance. Chief MacPherson said that due to the narrowness of the street, and that it is a one way, the Street would have to be block off while work is being done.
