3	The Zoning Board of Appeals for Tuesday, March 18,

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1	ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES OF

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4	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: The first
5	action this evening is for a motion to accept the
6	minutes of February 25^{th} and March 11^{th} , 2014
7	JOHN SERGI: So moved on both counts,
8	Madam Chair.
9	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Motion by Mr.
10	Sergi.
11	Do I have a second?
12	GORDON LASANE: Second.
13	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Second by Mr.
14	LaSane.
15	All in favor?
16	ALL BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.
17	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Opposed?
18	(None opposed.)
19	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: The ayes have
20	it.
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1	PUBLIC HEARING		
2	Case Number 2013-15: Frank D. Valentino, Jr. and		
3	Michael D. Valentino, 753-755 South Street		
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5	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Would the Clerk		
6	please read the petition in Case 2013-15, Valentino?		
7	MARK HICKERNELL: (The Clerk reads the		
8	notice for the above-mentioned Case into the record.		
9	See Attached.)		
10	BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Thank you.		
11	May we hear from the Petitioner or the		
12	Petitioner's representative please?		
13	ATTORNEY RICHARD DACEY: Thank you,		
14	Madam Chairperson, members of the Board. My name is		
15	Richard Dacey. I do represent the Petitioners this		
16	evening in this matter. I have Mr. Frank Valentino		
17	with me.		
18	This matter has been continued until		
19	tonight. We did make a different set of plans, or		
20	order a different set of plans. And I'll give you		
21	the basis for that set. It has become increasingly		
22	apparent to the Petitioner that the variance and the		
23	side yard was a real impediment to progress here.		
24	So, the suggestion was that we think in terms of		

- altering the structure of the building by removing
 the encroachment on the northerly side of the
 building, literally by cutting the building back. As
 you might well suspect, for an existing building that
 is a bit of a task, but it's doable.
- 6 So, we had a set of plans drawn. 7 expected them last week. Unfortunately, I wasn't 8 able to monitor the progress as well as I could have 9 for reasons that should be obvious to at least four 10 of you. But the plans did arrive yesterday. We took 11 them down to the Building Inspector's office. 12 there were a whole series of questions generated by 13 the plans.

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- The basic premise of the plan is to remove the portion of the building on the northerly side that currently encroaches into the side yard and literally bring the building back into conformity with the northerly side yard. This also anticipates removing the third floor, both in the addition and in the area over the original structure of the building. So that with this latest alteration, the building will conform to the current dimensional requirements of the zoning ordinance.
- As I said, it's a little complicated,

- and the plans arrived yesterday. We spent an hour
- with the Building Inspector. He had some comments.
- 3 He had some questions. And the plans, as a result,
- 4 need a rather significant revision to accommodate his
- 5 issues.
- 6 This is what prompted my request for a
- 7 continuance. I left the Building Inspector's office
- 8 and went up to your Clerk and told Pam that I would
- 9 be requesting a continuance, trying to give you as
- much notice as I could of what was actually going to
- 11 happen. I also emailed her this morning and
- 12 hopefully that got circulated to you so this request
- isn't a complete surprise.
- I did copy the neighbors so that they
- were at least aware of what my intention would be
- 16 tonight to ask for a continuance.
- The question was, was it worth it to
- bring Attorney Learned in tonight. And my suggestion
- was no. I think it's probably more appropriate that
- she see the revised plans and then base her comments
- 21 on that.
- So, the purpose -- my true purpose
- 23 here this evening is A) to apologize that the plans
- 24 weren't ready in time for us to really work them

- 1 through, but B) to request a continuance to a date 2 Board, that's convenient to the with the 3 understanding that these plans will be reviewed by 4 the Building Inspector, submitted in time for you to 5 review them along with a revised proposed findings of 6 fact and proposed decision. And, hopefully, at the 7 next meeting it will be your discretion as to whether think 8 not you still the Law Department's 9 involvement is necessary or whether this case is 10 carved back to a point where you're comfortable. 11 I think the case is a lot cleaner 12 without the variance and without the encroachment. 13 So, it's entirely your choice at that point. But it 14 didn't seem appropriate for us to be battling on 15 theoretics tonight where the plans are obviously 16 going to undergo a rather significant change, moving 17 project towards a less intense 18 conforming structure. 19 So, we don't have a particular date in 20 mind. It's at your pleasure.
- BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: All right.
- Does anyone have any questions of Attorney Dacey
- 23 before we get a date?
- 24 (No Board members have questions.)

- 1 All right. Are you thinking May,
- 2 Attorney Dacey?

- 6 BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: I have May 6th
- 7 or 13^{th} .
- 8 ATTORNEY RICHARD DACEY: Either one is
- 9 fine with me.
- BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Which one, Mr.
- 11 McCarthy? Will you be traveling?
- 12 EDWARD MCCARTHY: End of May, so the
- earlier the better I suppose so one could get it over
- 14 with.
- BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: All right. The
- 16 6th?
- 17 EDWARD MCCARTHY: Yeah, that would be
- 18 better.
- 19 BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: So we will
- 20 continue Case 2013-15 to May 6, 2014.
- 21 ATTORNEY RICHARD DACEY: We will have
- 22 to sign an extension, I believe.
- BARBARA RANDO, CHAIR: Right. What is
- 24 the extension time?
