December 17, 2018 – Waltham, MA – The Waltham Fire Department announces the renovation and new construction of the Moody Street Fire Station. Chief Thomas MacInnis of the Waltham Fire Department and Ward 8 Councilor, **Cathyanne Harris** would like to extend sincere thanks and appreciation to **Mayor Jeannette McCarthy**, the entire **Waltham City Council**, Purchasing Agent, **Joseph Pedulla**, Building Department Inspector **Jon Millan**, the Fire Department Moody Street Station Committee members [**Deputy Tim Pratt, Capt. The estimated schedule construction schedule for this project is as follows:

Demolition of the Young Building	4 to 6 Weeks
Completion of Construction Documents	By the end of January 2019
Bids for the construction project	February 2019
Funding Request	March/April
Construction commencing	Late Spring of 2019
