MBTA COMMUTER RAIL POSITIVE TRAIN CONTROL PROGRAM UPDATE

Advisory: Drill Work on Fitchburg Commuter Rail Line Dec. 23 & Dec. 30

Work from Waltham to Weston will occur 6AM-6PM

MassDOT and the MBTA are undertaking federally mandated Positive Train Control (PTC) infrastructure installation which will increase the safety of commuter rail customers and would like to advise the community of upcoming daytime drill work within the right-of-way along the MBTA Fitchburg Commuter Rail Line. <u>Due to the equipment necessary to perform</u> <u>this work, high noise levels can be expected</u>.

On Saturday, December 23, 2017, the PTC Systems Integrator Ansaldo STS USA, Inc. will perform rock drilling activities during daytime work hours of between approximately 6AM – 6PM. If this work is not completed, work will resume during same hours on Saturday, December 30, 2017.

The work will take place along the Fitchburg Line from the area in the vicinity of Waltham Station in Waltham to the area in the vicinity of Kendall Green Station in Weston.
