ATTENTION!

Due to the increasing rodent population in the City of Waltham, it has become a "Public Health Emergency" (M.G.L. c. 111, s: 127A).

All refuse put out at the curbside for collection must be in water tight barrels with tight fitting lids and no holes. They cannot be overfilled, nor be put out at curbside in plastic bags only (City Ordinance; Chapter 7. Article 1 Sec 7-7)

If this is a continued practice fines will be issued.
