RODENT ADVISORY

Due to the increasing rodent population in certain neighborhoods in the City of Waltham, it has become a “Public Health Emergency” (M.G.L. c.111, s: 127A).

The Waltham Health Department will be aggressively ticketing any and all property owners that do not store or put out their trash and rubbish properly. All refuse must be in barrels with tight fitting lids and cannot be left at the curb for pick up in plastic bags (410.600).

The Department will also order clean-up of any unsanitary properties and rodent control when necessary.
