This Addendum No. 1 is to answer the following questions asked at the pre-bid site walk, and to modify, correct and/or supplement the Plans, Specifications and Form for Bid.

Bidders are hereby informed that Plans and Specifications for the above-mentioned project are modified, corrected and/or supplemented as follows and that Addendum No. 1 becomes a part of the Contract Documents. Addendum No. 1 consists of answers to the Pre-bid Questions, Items 1 through 3, Drawing changes shown in SK L-1 through SKL-3, attached, and new Form for General Bid, attached.

Pre-bid Questions

- Q1. What will happen to the mound of infield mix currently stored on the pathway next to the batting cage?
 - A1. The City of Waltham will remove the infield mix prior to the start of the contract.
- Q2. Is the large tree at the northeastern corner of the ballfield fence to be removed?
 - A1. All trees within the area shown for clearing and grubbing shall be removed, including the tree at the corner noted as 24" on the survey, adjacent to the existing hydrant.

The following revisions are made a part of this Contract

- ITEM NO. 1 Revision to Specifications Section 01010 Summary of Work, paragraph 1.03 Contract Time and Sequencing. Revise 1.03.A.1 to read as follows:
 - "1. The time for substantial completion for the parking lot area improvements is 75 days from the Contractor's receipt of the Notice to Proceed. The work of the parking lot area shall include the binder course of new vehicular paving, adjacent pedestrian pathway paving, guardrail, chain link fence, parking lot signage, steel service gate, bronze plaque, and fixed bollards. The top course of parking lot paving and parking lot line

painting shall be completed in the spring, prior to April 1st."

ITEM NO. 2 Revision to Specifications Section 01040 Control of the Work. Add the following paragraph 1.10.D.2:

"The Contractor shall obtain and pay for a Temporary Construction Permit from the Division of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), Permit Section, 251 Causeway Street, 7th Floor, Boston 02114. The cost of the permit is \$1490. The permit application has been filed by Carolyn Cooney & Associates and has been approved to be finalized upon receipt of the Contractor's name and construction schedule. "
