- **Q1**. Is the HVAC sub responsible for any coring that is required?
- A1. YES
- **Q2**. Is the HVAC sub responsible for their own fire stopping?
- A2. YES
- **Q3**. Is the HVAC sub responsible for disconnecting and dropping to floor all HVAV items being removed and disposed of?
- A3. YES
- **Q5.** Phase 2 specifications, Section 02081, below item 1.02, B. 13, refers to a survey report attached to the bid specifications. I do not see it in the specs. Is it to be provided?
- **A5.** This question refers to the abatement of asbestos which is not part of the scope of work for this project. The abatement of asbestos will be done by the city prior to the commencement of the project
